<u>Code of Conduct - Players</u> <u>Junior Section</u>

- I. Pay the the appropriate annual subscription fee.
- 2. Register for EVERY training session.
- 3. NEVER use any foul or abusive language.
- 4. Show respect to the coaches and managers at the Club.
- 5. Respect other junior members of the club as well as their property.
- 6. Set a positive example to others, particularly younger members of the Club and to spectators as well.
- 7. Always treat your opponents with respect whatever the outcome of the game.
- 8. Respect all officials at any matches in which you play. Do not abuse or argue with officials in any way; remember that you are representing Harrogate Hockey Club and your behavior reflects on the Club.
- 9. Accept victory and defeat equally.
- 10. Come with the correct clothing and equipment hockey stick, shin pads with ankle protection, astro-turf shoes, gum shield, warm and wet weather clothing (all items named) and plenty of non-fizzy drink.
- 11. NEVER play on the pitch without a qualified coach being present.
- 12. NEVER train if you are injured or unwell.
- 13. ALWAYS inform your coach or manager if you are taking any medication or have any health condition that could affect your performance at training or on match days e.g. asthma.
- 14. Make every effort to develop your maximum sporting abilities in terms of skills, techniques, tactics and stamina.
- 15. Do NOT travel to away matches on your own in an adult's car without your parent's / guardian's prior permission.
- 16. ALWAYS notify your manager or coach of any dates for which you are unavailable for matches and try to give as much notice as possible. NEVER simply fail to turn up for a match.
- 17. ALWAYS remove litter from the pitches whether HOME or AWAY. There's always a bin available!
- 18. It is an offence for any under 18s to purchase or consume alcohol on Club premises.
- 19. Absolutely no smoking on Club premises.
